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## **Eastern Oregon Border Economic Development Board Property Improvement Rebate Program**

**WHAT:** Property owners who make eligible improvements to specific existing or new properties in the Border Region, that increase the tax assessed value by a minimum of \$10,000, will receive a rebate of \$20,000 or 15% of the increased value (whichever is less). Eligible activities include, but are not limited to, façade improvements, structural repairs, major remodels and new development of multi-family residential, commercial or industrial properties.

**WHO:** Property owners of existing residential, commercial or industrial properties and new development of multi-family residential, commercial and industrial properties within the Border Region. Building permits are required.

**WHERE:** The Border Region is defined as a part of Oregon that is within 20 miles of the Oregon border with the state of Idaho, and includes but is not limited, the cities of Ontario, Vale, Nyssa. It includes Willowcreek and Brogan and is an area in Oregon that is across the Oregon border from Weiser, Idaho and an area southwest of Vale for a distance of 10 miles. Please note that projects within the Vale School District and Annex School District are currently not eligible for this program, as those taxing districts are not participating in this program.

**WHY:** The Eastern Oregon Border Board is tasked with formulating and implementing strategies for investing in workforce and economic development in the Eastern Oregon Border Region. Providing a rebate to improve existing residential, commercial or industrial properties or incentivizing new multi-family residential, commercial and industrial properties within the Region does just that.

Please include photos/plans and receipts for the project, evidence/documentation showing the assessed value of the improved property has increased by a minimum of \$10,000 and evidence/documentation showing the property taxes are current. (Property taxes must remain current for the 10-year reimbursement period).
